


In the meeting that took place on 8 and 9, in the headquarters of the National Science Foundation, in Arlington, Virginia, USA, the Region was presented


- ◆ **Workshop of Stations and Biomes in Fairbanks, Alaska, from 22 to 25**

Already is in the task of translating the guides of stations and biomes, to begin to be employed at the identification of the biomes of every region.






MARCH
