- To a poster in a language other than English, add a transcript of the interview.
- Send us a [media release form](#) signed by each adult and by the parent of each student on the poster.

TREE TV

SHOOT YOUR CONVERSATION WITH A TREE IN A MAXIMUM 1-MINUTE LONG VIDEO.

- Don't forget to introduce yourselves as GLOBE Program Reporters.
- You can shoot your video in English or in your own language. In both cases, add English subtitles to the video or write down the transcript of what was said in the video.
- Send us a [media release form](#) signed by each adult and by the parent of each student in the video.
